


Weber Smokey Mountain Probe Eyelet Installation Instructions


Parts Needed:

Adjustable Wrench
Allen Key

Parts Included:

- 8-32 x 3/4" hex head cap screw (1)
- Eyelet flaring tool (1) Eyelet (2) 8-32 hex nut (1)














- 1. Remove the upper bolt from one of the grill holder brackets on your WSM.
- 2. Place the Eyelet Flaring tool (B) on the hex head cap screw (A) and insert it through the hole from the inside. (Fig. 1)
- 3. Place the Eyelet (C) on the hex head cap screw (A) from the outside and screw on the hex nut (D).
- 4. Make sure that the Eyelet assembly is positioned so the Eyelet flange (C) is flush against the outside wall of your cooker.
- 5. Using an adjustable wrench, hold the hex nut (D) and tighten the hex head cap screw (A) using the supplied Allen key from inside the cooker. (Fig. 2)
- 6. Continue tightening until the Eyelet splits and flares out (Fig. 3) and is secure in place. **
- 7. Remove the hex head cap screw (A), hex nut (D), and eyelet-flaring tool (B) and your new eyelet is installed and ready to accept THE BBQ GURU PROBES or temperature monitor probes as well as thin stem dial thermometers.
- 8. Reuse the tool for installing other eyelets.

NOTE: Do not over tighten or you could crack or chip the porcelain coating of the cooker.
